

Statement of Source

Peracetic Acid 15% Solution

Peracetic Acid 15% Solution is a liquid mixture of hydrogen peroxide and acetic acid. The concentration of hydrogen peroxide is about 22% and acetic acid is about 16%. The exact concentration will be provided on the COA.

Hydrogen peroxide is produced through anthraquinone autoxidation (AO) process where oxygen is utilized as a source.

Acetic acid used in production of peracetic acid is a biobased product sourced from hardwood produced during the extraction of pulps through biorefining process.

No animal products or derivatives are utilized in the production process of both hydrogen peroxide and acetic acid.

Source of hydrogen peroxide: Oxygen.

Source of acetic acid: Hardwood.

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
